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Figure 6 shows the results of the regression analysis. The dependent variable is the number of days off work due to musculoskeletal problems. The independent variables are age, sex, job tenure, education, income, and job characteristics. The model explains 18% of the variance in the dependent variable. The results show that older workers (age 40+) have significantly more days off work than younger workers (age 20-39). Female workers have significantly more days off work than male workers. Workers with less than 10 years of job tenure have significantly more days off work than workers with 10 or more years of job tenure. Workers with less than a high school diploma have significantly more days off work than workers with a high school diploma or higher. Workers with lower income have significantly more days off work than workers with higher income. Job characteristics such as physical demands, mental demands, and social support also have significant effects on the number of days off work.

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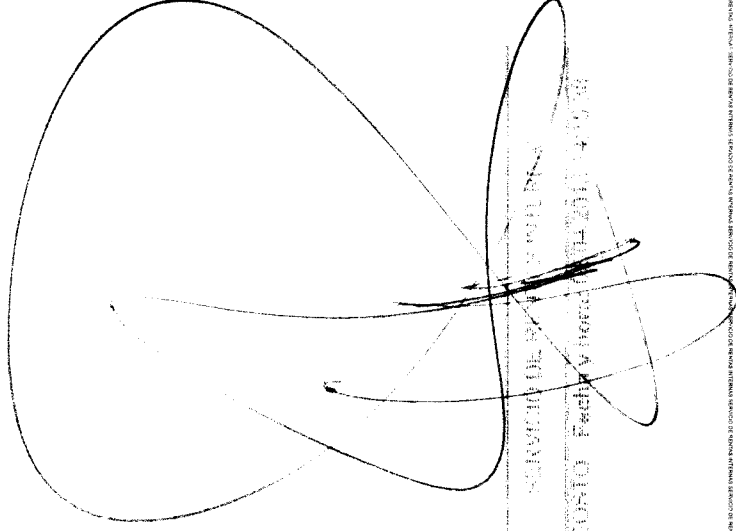
