Abstract—The purpose of this study was to determine the effect of a 10-week training program on the heart rate (HR) and heart rate reserve (HRR) of sedentary middle-aged men. The subjects were 15 men, 40 to 50 years old, who had been sedentary for at least 10 years. They were randomly assigned to a 10-week training program or a control group. The training program consisted of 30 minutes of aerobic exercise, 3 times a week, at 70% of the maximum HR. The control group did not exercise. The HR and HRR were measured at rest and during a maximal exercise test at the beginning and at the end of the 10-week period. The results showed that the training program had a significant effect on the HR and HRR of the subjects. The HR at rest decreased from 72 to 68 beats per minute (b·min⁻¹), and the HRR increased from 28 to 32 b·min⁻¹. The HR at maximal exercise also decreased from 185 to 175 b·min⁻¹, and the HRR at maximal exercise increased from 113 to 107 b·min⁻¹. The results suggest that a 10-week training program can improve the cardiovascular fitness of sedentary middle-aged men.
