1.1.1. Kinematics: Describing Motion

Displacement: The change in position of an object.

1.1.2. Dynamics: Causes of Motion

Newton's First Law: An object at rest stays at rest, and an object in motion stays in motion with the same speed and in the same direction unless acted upon by an unbalanced force.

1.1.3. Newton's Second Law

Force: A push or pull upon an object that causes it to accelerate.

Mass: A measure of the amount of matter in an object.

Action-Reaction: For every action, there is an equal and opposite reaction.

Energy: The capacity to do work.
