- “*Leviathan*” (1651) is a political tract by Thomas Hobbes, in which he argues that the state is the only entity capable of maintaining order and preventing civil strife. The book is divided into two main parts: “The First Part of Leviathan” and “The Second Part of Leviathan”. The first part discusses the nature of the state and its power, while the second part discusses the relationship between the state and its subjects. Hobbes’ ideas have had a significant influence on political thought and philosophy.
