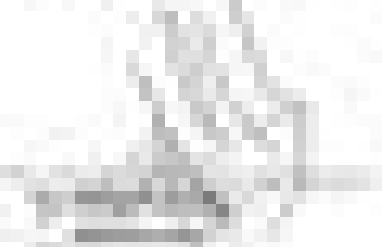

Diagram of the Earth's interior showing the layers of the Earth and the boundaries between them.

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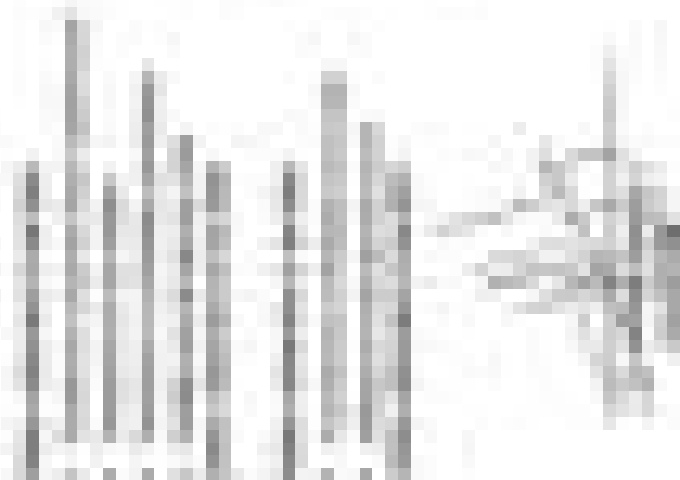
