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14. **CONSTITUTIONAL LAW**—The U.S. Constitution is the supreme law of the land. It defines the powers and limitations of the federal government and the states. The Constitution is divided into seven articles. Article I establishes the legislative branch (Congress). Article II establishes the executive branch (the President). Article III establishes the judicial branch (the Supreme Court). Articles IV, V, and VI deal with the relationship between the states and the federal government. Article VII describes the process of ratification. The Constitution is amended by a process described in Article V. There are 27 amendments to the Constitution. The first ten amendments are known as the Bill of Rights. The Bill of Rights guarantees certain individual liberties, such as freedom of speech, religion, and the press. The remaining 17 amendments address various other issues, such as the structure of the government and the rights of states and citizens.
