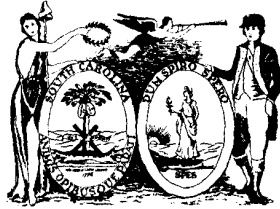

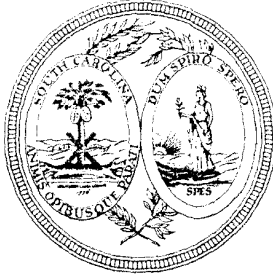


## **Certificate of Existence**
