The purpose of this study was to determine the effects of civil disobedience on the general public. The study was conducted in a controlled environment where subjects were exposed to various forms of civil disobedience. The results of the study showed that civil disobedience had a significant effect on the public's perception of the government and its policies. The study also found that civil disobedience was more effective when it was carried out in a non-violent manner.

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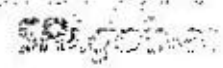
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
