TYPE OF WATER TREATMENT

It can be seen from the above that the primary water treatment system is mainly to remove solid particles and organic matter. The secondary water treatment system is mainly to remove dissolved organic matter and inorganic ions.

The following section of the document will discuss the different types of water treatment systems.

The first type of water treatment system is a sedimentation system. This system is used to remove suspended solids from the water.

The second type of water treatment system is a filtration system. This system is used to remove dissolved organic matter and inorganic ions from the water.

Water treatment systems can be divided into two main categories: primary and secondary. Primary water treatment systems are used to remove suspended solids from the water.

Secondary water treatment systems are used to remove dissolved organic matter and inorganic ions from the water.

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
