These academic progress of students reflected upon the learning outcomes taught at university programmes. The assessments are conducted under continuous and termly format, whereby students' performance are measured across the programme, in order to be presented in class. This will be apparent in the examination in the mid-term or the semester exams at the University, thus helping the students to measure their academic progress. The students' evaluations are to demonstrate a student's performance in each subject taught. Students' teacher evaluations shall be submitted to the University of Nottingham Malaysia, whereby each student is required to undergo with the various assignments given.
