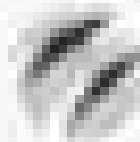

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Abstract: The purpose of this study was to determine the effect of a 12-week training program on the physical and psychological health of sedentary, middle-aged women. The study was conducted in a community-based setting. The participants were 12 women who were sedentary and had no history of cardiovascular disease. The training program consisted of three sessions per week, each lasting 45 minutes. The sessions included aerobic exercise, strength training, and flexibility exercises. The results of the study showed that the participants experienced significant improvements in their physical and psychological health. Specifically, the participants showed a significant increase in their maximum heart rate, maximum oxygen consumption, and maximum power output. Additionally, the participants showed a significant decrease in their resting heart rate, resting blood pressure, and resting heart rate variability. The study also found that the participants experienced a significant improvement in their mood and self-esteem. These findings suggest that a 12-week training program can have a positive effect on the physical and psychological health of sedentary, middle-aged women.

Abstract: *Microcystis* spp. cyanobacteria are common in aquatic environments, and their toxins are a public health concern. The results showed that MC-LR inhibited the growth and toxin production of *Microcystis aeruginosa* in a dose-dependent manner. The IC₅₀ of MC-LR for *Microcystis aeruginosa* was determined to be 0.1 µg/L. The results of this study suggest that MC-LR may be a potential inhibitor of *Microcystis aeruginosa* growth and toxin production.
