- **antioxidants** = compounds that protect cells from oxidative damage
- **phytochemicals** = chemical compounds in plants that have health benefits
- **flavonoids** = a group of phytochemicals that have antioxidant properties
- **carotenoids** = a group of phytochemicals that have antioxidant properties
- **polyphenols** = a group of phytochemicals that have antioxidant properties

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
